# No Rest for the Weary... Pre-Building Team Work Continues

The Pre-Building Team: Ken Hoffman, John White, Elgin Fry, April Hitch, Debbie Miller, Karen Nolan, Russ Andrews, with Chris Hitch and Rev. VerBurg, ex-offico and Dave Deardorff, Chairperson, got off to an enthusiastic start June 3 and met again on June 24.

Our summertime assignment is to explore all the possibilities for the next phase of our building program. Many of you are aware that further developing our current site presents us with some costly challenges, especially in the area of site preparation for a new sanctuary. The Team is hard at work identifying those challenges and their projected costs; as well as other site options.

- Members are busy contacting the appropriate Town of Cary officials for updated information regarding requirements affecting any proposed building programs as well as solutions to signage permits and visibility from the Parkway.
- At the April General Board meeting, we received the approval to secure an architectural consultant to review our property and make suggestions concerning any further development; who will meet with the Team on July 30.
- The Team is also investigating, with the help of a commercial real estate broker, the availability and related costs for a new location within a 5-7 mile radius of where we are now located.

Our plan is to continue gathering all necessary data by mid-August. Then, during September there will be scheduled times for everyone to receive the final report, laying out ALL our options so that YOU, members of the congregation, may make informed decisions about our future building plans.
