January 31st, our journey begins as we trek east to Beth Shalom (Cary's own Reformed Jewish Temple) and together participate in a service project that coincides with their Jewish holiday "Tu B'Shevat" the Rosh HaShanah for trees.

While visiting our neighbors Beth Shalom, our children will learn about the Jewish customs, beliefs, and their religious calendar.
