And yet, I had to leave and I knew that I *could* leave...knowing and trusting that in the words of the ancient mystic, Julian of Norwich, "All shall be well...and all manner of things shall be well..."

And well it all was...from the responsive leadership of our Moderator, Vice-Moderator and other congregational clergy, who responded to the "anticipated" surprises, filling in the blanks that yielded a seamless time of worship for all present; to those who filled the pulpit during both services each week; to the visits and attention of the Elders and others to those in great need; to the staff who kept many things going; especially Randy, who, in the midst of his own personal struggles, so ably responded with pastoral care to many; to the love and support this church family showed forth to Laura & Randy in their own time of great need when death came as a most unwelcomed guest in their lives.

How wonderfully gratifying it is to be in relationship, in ministry, with all of you as this strong, faithful, loving and caring church family; people who rise to any occasion, trusting God is right there with them, equipping them and blessing them to do the ministry set before them... It's a privilege to know you and to serve with you...**Blessings**, **Rev. Joanne**
