Thanks to the generosity of our church family and friends, it looks like we'll be "in the black" for December. General Fund contributions were over \$20K. We also received \$905 for Covenant members who worked shifts at the state fair. That's a wonderful way to bring the year to a close!

Of course, we continue to deal with the reality of the deficit for 2011. At this point, we expect that General Fund expenses will exceed income by almost \$30K for the 12 months. After much prayer and discussion, difficult decisions have been made in order to bring this into balance for 2012.

Detailed final year-end reports will be sent to the board by the middle of January. Anyone else who would like to review these reports can request a copy by contacting me directly.

I want to thank Mary Lou Jackson, Financial Secretary, for her hard work and attention to detail in recording our contributions, other income, and expenses. YOU CAN HELP. Be aware that when she is posting, *nothing on her computer screen shows your pledge amounts*. Please *mark EVERY check clearly*, indicating whether the check is for general fund, capital campaign, SCRIP, memorial, etc. This will help assure that your checks go to the proper account. (If you are using online bill pay, you can use the "account number" line to put this info into the check, if there is not a printable "memo" line in your bank's system).

We received around \$300.00 from SERRV; \$260 from the tree sales which will be used to help needy families in Ashe County. Also, through the growing season, the Garden of Hope raised around \$300 from sale of produce; proceeds going to the Interfaith Food Shuttle to help feed the hungry in Wake County.
